INFORMATION updates:

The tidy district judges were seen going around the estate, so we expect them to visit again prior to final judging, so please be pro active and pick up litter and keep the green areas in front of your houses maintained.

SECURITY:

Must re emphasise the importance of using Chubb locks and general security and the importance of not leaving car keys visible through hall window, as within the last two weeks a door was kicked in and car keys grabbed and a car stolen. So remember there are people going around looking for these opportunities. So store keys out of sight, lock downstairs windows and Chubb lock doors.

DOGS:

We have a major increase in dog dirt on the green area and around the estate again. This is simple to solve, so all dog owners should bring a bag with you and bin in and you should all have your dogs on leads please. This problem is actually very serious as the infections picked up through dog dirt causes 24 children to go blind each year in Ireland. Children do not see this danger when playing on the green, so dog owners and walkers must take responsibilities.

TRAFFIC:

A stop sign is been planned for the Silver Park exit / entrance slip road. DLRCC will be out in the next few months to touch up and extend yellow lines and erect a stop sign and an add a 'children at play' sign to warn drivers to slow down around the green area.

FEES:
