TREES UPDATE

DLRCoCo has undertaken further substantial works on the trees in Tudor Lawns. This was the third works schedule in 2015 which again proves the benefits of building and sustaining a good working relationship with the CoCo. The tree pruning has resulted in much improved lighting in the estate especially on those dark winter evenings.

The committee is continuing to engage with the CoCo on getting replacement trees at the entrance to TL and hopefully some further tree pruning works will be undertaken in the next 12/18 months on the last remaining trees that have not been addressed so far.

LEAVES SWEEPING BY DLRCoCo

The committee has managed to get additional road sweeping of leaves in TL over recent weeks and there is a promise of at least one more sweep before year-end. The CoCo cannot provide the dates or times of the road sweeps. To ensure that the residents get the maximum benefit from the road sweeping we would encourage residents, that are able, to sweep the leaves off the green spaces on to the roads around the green and in the areas where cars do not park to ensure that they are collected by the road sweeper. It is also a good idea to sweep up any leaves on the footpath outside your home as they can be very slippy and a trip hazard when wet.
